

KODIAK PARTICIPANT - PERSONAL EQUIPMENT LIST

Necessary Equipment

- ___ 1 short sleeve Venturing Uniform shirt

All badges and patches (except Council Shoulder patch, American Flag and Order of the Arrow Pocket) must be removed from your uniform shirts. This includes badges of office, rank, crew numbers, etc. You will sew your VLT Crew Numbers on your shirt while on the bus. **Have your sewing kit handy.**

- ___ 1 Pr Zip-off Pants – Tan/Khaki
OR
- ___ 1 Pr Hiking Shorts – Tan/Khaki &
- ___ 1 Pr Long pants – Tan/Khaki
- ___ 2-3 pair sock liners
- ___ 3 pair wool or equivalent hiking socks
- ___ 2 T-shirts - Scout related or plain with no print
- ___ Web belt suitable for backpacking
- ___ Shoes, Tennis type for in camp
Sneakers or something that can get wet! No open sandals!
- ___ Shoes, Hiking boots, proper fit and well broken in (for on the trail)
- ___ Rain coat or poncho
- ___ Stocking cap or equivalent cold weather head gear
- ___ Sweater or jacket
- ___ Underwear, at least four sets
- ___ Extra work shirt
- ___ Work jeans will get dirty
- ___ Towels
- ___ Wash cloth
- ___ Toothbrush and toothpaste
- ___ Hand soap in container
- ___ Mirror
- ___ Brush and/or comb
- ___ Swimsuit – ***Modest & appropriate for active water sports***
- ___ Backpack - ***adequate for carrying all gear to backpack overnight camps***
- ___ Chap-stick
- ___ Sunburn lotion
- ___ Insect Repellent
- ___ Two (2) Plastic 2-liter water bottles
- ___ 1 set eating utensils
- ___ 1 plastic bowl
- ___ Ground-cloth (8X10 ft or less; waterproof)
- ___ Backpack Tent or lightweight tarp (~10x10) poly or nylon
- ___ 50' of 1/8" Nylon or parachute cord
- ___ **Sleeping bag**

- ___ Air mattress (therma-rest type) or foam pad
- ___ Small flashlight with fresh batteries (bring extra batteries - tape terminals)
- ___ Backpack stove (**optional**) – if you have one & want to use it.)
- ___ **SEWING KIT (This is essential - you'll need it on the bus)**
- ___ Personal first aid kit
- ___ Personal Hygiene items
- ___ Personal medication (***Must be noted on your medical form and an updated Medication form turned in at the bus. All medication must be in pharmacy issued containers. No loose pills in plastic bags; no pill-boxes***)
- ___ Pen and Pencil (bring a couple extra)
- ___ Spiral bound notebook – single subject w/ 3 holes or Steno-Pad
- ___ Compass (Polaris or Explorer III)
- ___ **Watch <<<<**
- ___ Small Pocket Knife (palm size or smaller)
- ___ Venturing HANDBOOK
- ___ Blank VHS Video Tape with your name on it

Optional Equipment

- ___ Work gloves
- ___ Camera (inexpensive)
- ___ Pillow
- ___ Pajamas
- ___ Teddy Bear (just kidding)

All items are to be marked with your name.

Don't Bring:

- Food... *The Bears will like you if you do!*
- Fireworks
- Fixed Blade Knives
- Laser Pointers
- Radios, Stereos, Boom Boxes, Walkman, Computers, cell-phones, pagers or equivalent
- No Irreplaceable items
